Sterkfontein Country Estates March/Maart 2017


Good day country folk,

This is a very late and very short Celtis. Autumn is here - leaves are falling and early mornings one can feel that little bite in the air!

The Celtis this month is all just about a species of orchid Garfield discovered on our property. We have never seen this one before anywhere on the Estate and are really quite chuffed that he found it! This rather elegant and slender-looking orchid, the *Habenaria kraezliniana*, is quite rare. In the 1970's it was fairly common, but due to urbanization and neglectful town planning it is rarely seen. The flowers are whitish-green and it is easily identifiable by the long tendrils hanging from the lower lip of the petals. At a quick glance, one might confuse it with the *Bonatea antennifera*, but at closer look, its appearance is quite different.

On SANBI's red data list it is described as "near threatened" as **only 5-10 known** locations exist! According to our book on orchids it is seen as "rare" and "endangered". And now, we can say with confidence it is also found on our property! I would love to hear from others who may have spotted it on their property so we can record it as such – we need pictures folks, this data will be given over to the relevant people so don't try to cheat and say you have seen it! We actually recorded the co-ordinates so we know exactly where it was.

Not only is it great to have one of these rare species in our area, but also should we ever have another debacle such as we had with Escom some years ago; we have even more ammunition against development such as they had planned at the time.


